JOB DESCRIPTION

The Community Health Nurse uses professional knowledge and discretionary judgment to provide assessment, health care planning and management and ongoing monitoring of individuals who experience developmental disabilities. This includes care for adults and children with complex medical conditions and others who additionally experience mental health diagnoses. The Community Health Nurse provides consultation, education and direction to individuals, families and staff. The successful candidate must work independently in both urban and remote communities and may be called upon to respond to crisis situations. The Community Health Nurse will be expected to function independently and be a self starter. The Community Health Nurse maintains loyalty to the agency, including Hope's mission, vision, beliefs, values and expectations and to the recipients of services.

This position can be part-time or full-time, working 30-40 hours per week with a flexible schedule. The successful applicant could work remotely from different Kenai Peninsula Communities.
