Dear Colleagues, Friends, and Interested Parties:

During the past five years Hope has been working along with some founding advocates and families to establish an Intentional Neighborhood on the Kenai Peninsula. This neighborhood is located on 20 acres between Sterling and Soldotna. The neighborhood will be comprised of six homes, a club house style gathering place, and hopefully a barn and greenhouse will be added in the near future. Each home will have one home alliance coordinator (live in) who supports two community members. Members living within this neighborhood share the common philosophy of enjoying a country life style, while having daily access to their greater community around them. Growing plants, raising a garden, animal husbandry, and country walks are all examples of things to do around the homes, while going to church, shopping, employment, and movies are examples of things we will do in our greater community.

Members of the neighborhood are seeking staff who would like to be the live in home alliance coordinators. In their own words they see these work assignments as a "Great opportunity to be part of a neighborhood and community that embraces positivity and the rural lifestyle. All members of the community work together to support each other, enjoy companionships, and being in touch with nature. Those selected for positions will have the chance to work with a wide variety of people including families, community members, coworkers, and professionals to learn and grow professionally and personally. This is more than a job, it is a lifestyle. If this is for you come and share your talents with us and we will share our talents with you."

These live in positions are available now and we anticipate them starting as the homes begin to open in early January. There will be a training period involved. Employees currently working at Hope and who would enjoy this country life style are urged to apply. Job descriptions are available in our Human resources department. Come join the future!
